

EVENT FORMAT

SINGLES COMPETITION

- Prizes will be awarded to the top-performing individuals based on their lowest 54-hole gross score.
- Prizes will be awarded to the top-performing individuals based on their 54-hole stableford score.

TEAM COMPETITION

- Teams consist of four players (male and/or female - any combination of gender and age)*
- Schools may enter up to four teams (teachers can play in school teams).
- The top three Stableford scores for each round will be combined to establish each team's score for that round.
- Team prizes will be awarded to teams with the most cumulative Stableford points from all three rounds.

Playing Notes

- * If any school has less than four individuals, these individuals will compete in the Singles competitions only.
- - All players must have (and be able to present evidence of) an official WHS golf handicap.
- - WSG Golf is a shotgun start golfers will start at the same time, but on different tees.




