DALMAHOY (EAST)

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Dalmahoy GC for the Caddy Fundraising Tri-Am.

All covid rules and restrictions have been lifted in Scotland, but the virus has not gone away.

Use 'Covid sense' to protect yourself and others.

We would like to advise competitors of some information prior to attending the competition. Information has been categorised for ease of reading.

Please ensure you have read the [MCLGA Terms of Competition](#) before attending on the day.

Please ensure that all queries regarding the competition, including tee times, either before or on the day of the competition, are directed to secretary@mclga.com or the officials on site on the day and not to the Dalmahoy Professional.

LATE WITHDRAWALS

- If your team needs to withdraw before the competition or on the day, please email the Secretary in the first instance on secretary@mclga.com. If you do not get a reply within 15 minutes, then call **Maureen on 07709 743831**.

PARKING

- There should be plenty of parking spaces and there is an overflow car park. Car sharing is, however, encouraged and please park considerately to allow as many cars as possible.

BAR & CATERING

- The James Braid bar is open from 7am where teas and coffees will be available. Bacon and sausage rolls will also be available on a self-serve basis.
- A Bar menu will be available from 12:00 – 21:30 also in the James Braid bar

CHECK-IN

- Check-in will be on the **landing upstairs in the Country Club**, opposite the restaurant and beside the James Braid bar.
- Check-in will be to confirm attendance, collect scorecards, check in on your phone, tell the registration desk your team name and take part in the optional 4-ball raffle and 'Guess the Number of Tees'.

COMPETITION FORMAT and use of the SCOTTISH GOLF APP

- The competition is a Best 2 of 3 Stableford Tri-Am. All 3 players play their own ball in a Stableford competition recording their Gross scores.
 - All 3 players in a team will be using the Scottish Golf App, so please bring your phone fully charged.
 - Each player must check in on the App **before they play**. You can find out more about how to do this in Step 2 of the guide [here](#). Help will be available.
 - A hard scorecard must be also completed with the individual player's Gross Scores as back-up and for those who wish to enter scores in the clubhouse after playing.
 - Gross Scores must be entered into the Scottish Golf App – either on the course or when you come back into the clubhouse. You can find out more about how to do this in Step 3 of the guide [here](#). Help will be available.
 - The system will team up the 3 individual players and determine the 2 best Stableford scores per hole.

An information sheet will be available to take away for reference.

PRIZES

The following prizes (SG vouchers) will be awarded for the best team scores:

- 1st £50 x 3 = £150
- 2nd £40 x 3 = £120
- 3rd £30 x 3 = £90
- 4th £20 x 3 = £60
- 5th £10 x 3 = £30

There are also on-course prizes (also SG vouchers)

- Nearest the Pin (4th and 7th) for everyone = £10
- Nearest the Wiggly Line (10th and 15th) = £10

Best Team Name

There will also be a prize for the best team name so get your thinking caps on!

FEMALE LOCKER ROOM

- The female locker room will be available for your use and is in the main clubhouse.

OPTIONAL RAFFLE and Guess Number of Tees

- A raffle for 4-Ball vouchers will be in operation. Participation is optional and cost will be £4 per square or £20 for 6. **Juniors may not participate in the raffle.**
- There will also be an opportunity to win a Gin Collection gift set by guessing the number of tees – only 50p a guess!

LOCAL RULES

- All local rules are on the Dalmahoy GC scorecard.
- There is currently have a large number of geese out on the course. There is an additional local rule to deal with droppings which can be viewed on the notice board in the starters lodge.
- Preferred lies will NOT be in operation unless there are adverse weather conditions.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

- The driving range will be available, tokens can be bought at the clubhouse reception at members discount price. There is also a short game practice area available for use with your own balls.

STARTING PLAY

- Players should report into the Starters lodge **10 minutes before Tee off time**. They will have a start sheet and keep you informed of any delays etc.
- Play will be from the **Red Tees**.

ON COURSE DISTANCE MEASURES

- There are markers on the right-hand side of most holes indicating 100 or 150 yards to the centre of the green and disks on the fairways indicating the following distances in yards also to the centre of the green:

○ RED	= 100
○ YELLOW	= 150
○ WHITE	= 200

- The flags are coloured as follows:

○ RED	= front
○ YELLOW	= middle
○ WHITE	= back

SPOTTERS and BELL at the 9TH

- We hope to have ball spotters in strategic places to help with pace of play.
- There is a bell at the 9th before the wall, please remember to ring it.

COURSE TOILET

- The course comes back to the Starters lodge after the 9th hole where toilets are available.

ADVERSE WEATHER

- In the event of bad weather causing unplayable or dangerous conditions, a klaxon will be sounded to suspend play.
 - **Klaxon codes** – 1 long blast – play suspended. 2 long blasts – play restarted. Repeated long blasts – possible danger. Players advised to leave course immediately.

SUBMITTING SCORES

- Scottish Golf App: Scores are also to be submitted using the Scottish Golf App using the guide provided. Assistance will be available to those who need help.
- Playing Handicap: please note that throughout the Scottish Golf App and system, the Playing Handicap will not appear – however the correct 85% allocation of the Course Handicap for Tri-Am competitions will have been applied when calculating the results.

LEADERBOARD and RESULTS

- The Leaderboard will be available in the **Scottish Golf App** during the competition.
 - Go into the 3 dots bottom right of the App
 - Select 'My Competitions' and click on the competition in question
 - Select 'Division' to switch between A and B
 - You can select Gross and change this to Net
- The Results will appear in the same place in the App when the competition has closed.
- All results will be also detailed in a report on the MCLGA website.
